Goal of Lead SAVY:

Become a mentor for SAVYs and assist with daily duties to ensure the standards of the SAVY program are met.

Lead SAVY Qualifications:

- Must have completed at least two consecutive sessions of the SAVY program.
- Must be in good standing in the program.
- Must complete an interview.

Lead SAVY Expectations:

- Must be on-time!
- Check that the SAVY participants on stations are :
 - o In proper uniform.
 - o Following policies.
 - o Interacting with guests.
- Provide training as needed or requested.
- Provide restroom breaks if needed.
- Check the cart conditions/supplies and notify Volunteer Services if anything is needed.
- Report any concerns to Volunteer Services.
- Assist with Pre-shift meetings
- Attend (MANDATORY) and assist with both SAVY Orientations to aid with training
 - May 31st and June 1st
- Attend MANDATORY Lead SAVY Training
 - o June 4th

Please Consider the Following when Applying for SAVY

- The SAVY Program requires at least 6 shifts in June, 6 shifts in July, and 3 shifts in August. Each shift is 4 hours. Applicants should determine if they have fortitude or time to successfully complete the program.
- Applicants must be at least 14 by August 31, 2019. Applicants who will be 18 by August 31, 2019 will not be accepted into the program, but should consider the adult volunteer program. (*Email volunteers@moodygardens.org for additional information on the adult program.*)
- Participants must attend an interview, orientation, any necessary training sessions and continuing education programs as requested in order to carry out the duties of their assigned tasks.
- Participants must be dependable and reliable, and carry out their duties in a professional manner.
- Uniform shirts are provided but participants must supply their own black/khaki shorts or pants, brown or black belt, and closed toed shoes.
