Lead SAVY Application

Goal of Lead SAVY:

Become a mentor for SAVYs and assist with daily duties to ensure the standards of the SAVY program are met.

Lead SAVY Qualifications:

- Must have completed at least two consecutive sessions of the SAVY program.
- Must be in good standing in the program.
- Must complete an interview.

Lead SAVY Expectations:

- Must be on-time
- Check that the SAVY participants on stations are :
 - In proper uniform
 - Following policies
 - Interacting with guests
- Provide training as needed or requested
- Provide restroom breaks if needed
- Check the cart conditions/supplies and notify Volunteer Services if anything is needed
- Report any concerns to Volunteer Staff
- Assist with Pre-shift meetings
- Attend **MANDATORY** Lead SAVY Training
- Attend and assist with **both** SAVY Orientations to aid with training
- **Complete 8 shifts in June (4 Exhibit/4 Behind the Scenes (BTS))**
- **Complete 8 Shifts in July (4 Exhibit/ 4 BTS)**
- **Complete 4 shifts in August (2 Exhibit/ 2 BTS)**
- Attend 4 Continuing Education Classes

Please Consider the Following when applying for the Lead SAVY Position:

- The Lead SAVY Position requires at least 8 shifts in June, 8 shifts in July, and 4 shifts in August. Each shift is 4 hours. Applicants should determine if they have fortitude or time to successfully complete these requirements.
- Applicants who will be 18 by August 31 will not be accepted into the program, but should consider the adult volunteer program. (*Email volunteers@moodygardens.org for additional information on the adult program.*)
- Lead Participants must attend an interview, both SAVY orientations, any other necessary training sessions and continuing education programs as requested in order to carry out the duties of their assigned tasks.
- Participants must be dependable and reliable, and carry out their duties in a professional manner.
- Uniform shirts are provided but participants must supply their own black or khaki shorts or pants, brown or black belt, and black or white closed toed shoes.

Application Instructions:

- Fill out the form COMPLETELY. **Incomplete forms will not be considered.**
- Provide a **typed** full page essay about your future goals and how you feel the SAVY Program can help you accomplish those goals. (*Times New Roman, 12 pt font, SINGLE SPACED*)
- Provide a copy of your most recent report card or homeschool evaluation
- **The application must be completed by the applicant.**
