Youth in grades K-8th may be registered to attend Moody Gardens Pyramid Kids Summer Camp. Programs will consist of different age appropriate activities, games and experiments making it unique every day for your camper.

Campers will be separated into 4 groups for age appropriate activities and learning experiences. Each camper grouping has a maximum of 24 campers each with a minimum of a 1:12 supervision ratio. REGISTER FOR THE GRADE LEVEL YOUR CAMPER WILL BE ENTERING INTO FOR THE FALL 2023 SCHOOL YEAR.

Experiences Included:

- Discover and explore our attractions, participating in design challenges, conducting experiments, and creating works of art inspired by nature.
- Hear firsthand from our staff about the role we all serve in ecosystem conservation.
- Work with your fellow campers on projects, games and other fun activities.
- Experience presentations with the Moody Gardens Animal Ambassadors.
- Make memories and friends that will last a lifetime!
- Camp programs run from 9:30am-4:30pm and include attraction(s) every day, weather permitting.

The following are items campers MUST bring daily:

- NON-PERISHABLE LUNCH --- name clearly marked
- Reusable water bottle --- name clearly marked
- Backpack/bag with their lunch inside --- name clearly marked
- Closed-toed shoes --- must be wearing to participate

- 5) After selecting a camp registration for each of your campers, scroll to the bottom of the page and click the green “Add to Cart” button. In your Shopping Cart, select the “Enter Roster Information” link below each camp registration you have added. Enter the information requested regarding yourself and your camper(s) for our registration records. Select “Continue” at the bottom of the page to return to your Shopping Cart.
- 6) Scroll to the “Totals” section of your Shopping Cart. Select the green “Checkout” button. You will be prompted to check out as a Returning Customer, New Customer or Guest. You may either enter your account information at this time if you’ve already created a Moody Gardens Web Store Account, create a new account, or proceed to checkout as a guest. If you are a member, you will want to login to your account or create a new one. Click on “Forgot Password” to reset your password if you have forgotten it.
- 7) After arriving at the Checkout page, select your delivery method as Print At Home. Complete your billing and payment information as listed on the page. Select “Submit Order” at the bottom of your page to complete your camp registration. You should receive an email confirmation of your camp registration within the next 24 hours. If you do not receive this confirmation, or if you encounter any issues with our online registration portal, please contact our department directly via phone or email at camps@moodygardens.org or (409)683-4211.

Cancellations, Exchanges and Refunds

- Due to the high demand for camp spaces, each sale will be considered final.
- Refunds will not be issued for full or partial camp days or weeks that individual campers miss due to illness, behavioral challenges or other circumstances.
- Individuals who cancel their camper(s) camp registration will receive a 50% refund of the cost of a camp if we receive written notification only of the cancelation at least 14 working days before the start of that camp. Contact the Education Department in writing at camps@moodygardens.org. No refunds will be issued for a cancelled camp registration received less than 14 working days before that camp begins.
- Individuals may switch their camper(s) registration from one camp week to another if they submit a written request to camps@moodygardens.org at least 14 working days before the start of the camp they are switching to. Please keep in mind there is no guarantee for alternate dates, as they are subject to availability. If you need to switch camp weeks, it is advised to contact us as soon as possible. Moody Gardens will not issue refunds if there are no alternate camp weeks available.
- Moody Gardens reserves the right to cancel camps that do not meet minimum enrollment requirements. If a camp is cancelled by the Education Department, individuals will receive a full refund if they are unable to transfer their registration to another camp week offered in the season.

Uniforms and Safety Gear

- During Monday morning check-in, one camp t-shirt will be provided to each camper as their required uniform for the week (included with the cost of a full week camp registration). All campers must wear their mandatory camp t-shirt each day to help ensure their safety and proper identification while on Moody Gardens property with our camp counselors. Parents may purchase additional shirts (\$19.49 each, including tax) for their camper to ensure they have a clean uniform for each day of camp. If for any reason a camper is dropped off without wearing their camp t-shirt, you must purchase a shirt for them to change into before camp activities begin.
- All campers must wear closed-toed shoes and arrive to camp with sunscreen/bug spray already applied. Campers are advised to bring their own sunscreen and bug spray to reapply on their own throughout the day.
- We will visit Palm Beach once during the camp week, weather permitting, at the end of a day. There is **NO SWIMMING INVOLVED** in this activity. Campers will be restricted to one area only of Palm Beach with slides and a minimal water depth (above the ankle). Information regarding this camp activity will be provided to parents prior to the activity usually the day before. In order to attend Palm Beach, all campers must wear their camp T-shirt and bring a towel. There will not be any changing into alternate clothes before or after the activity. It is advised they wear fast drying clothes. Your child will not be completely dry at pick up; we will be leaving Palm Beach and headed directly to car line location for afternoon pick up.

Camp Drop off – Pick up Logistics

- Camp begins at 9:30am each day with a drop off location at the Main Parking Lot Tram Stop. (See map in the appendix.)
 - **DROP OFF TIME: 9:00 am – 9:30 am**
 - **PICK UP TIME: 4:30 pm – 5:00 pm**
- Drop-Off/Pick-Up Line- Parents will pull up along the curb next to the Main Parking Lot Tram Stop and remain in their vehicles to sign their camper(s) in and out each day of camp with a camp counselor. After you have dropped off or picked up your camper(s), please move your vehicle forward to keep the line moving.
- You must park in a parking lot space before entering the car line if you are applying Sunscreen or Bug Spray to your camper.
- All campers will participate in free play on our playground during pick-up and drop-off times under the supervision of Camp Counselors.
- Camp Counselors will begin camp at 9:30 each morning and return to the playground at 4:25pm each afternoon for the start of pick-up.

- Camp Counselors or parents may request one-on-one conferences with each other to address inquiries regarding camp activities, policies or behavioral needs of their camper(s). In this case, parents will be asked to pull forward, stay in their car and park in the designated spot in order for the car line to continue for other families.
- **No car line before 4:25! Security will have you move and park until pick up time.** If you arrive early you must park in a general parking lot space. Only at 4:25 may you proceed to start the line. Please do NOT block the entrance into the parking garage under the hotel.
- There will be NO in person walk up to a counselor for pick up or drop off. Car line only.

Camp will continue as scheduled during rain and thunderstorms, and we will provide alternative indoor activities for all campers. We may also schedule property transportation to move campers from one indoor location to another based upon availability and weather conditions.

In the event of a hurricane or other extreme severe weather Moody Gardens will determine whether or not to close camps. We will make every effort to announce a camp closure as quickly as possible once the decision has been made. If you have any questions regarding a possible camp closure, please contact our Education Curator at (409)683-4233. If camp is closed by Moody Gardens due to a severe weather incident, attempts will be made to reschedule your camper into another camp or an additional “make up” camp week immediately following. Refunds will not be given in advance if there is threat of severe weather. In the event of a closure, and no alternate week available only a 50% refund will be given.

Early Release / Before & After Care

- All camp registrations include the cost of your camper(s) attending camp from 9:30am-4:30pm Monday-Friday of their chosen camp week(s). If you wish to pick up your camper(s) earlier in the day, please arrange this at the time of drop off or directly with the Camp Coordinator 409-683-4211 or Education Curator 409-683-4233.
- Before and After Care provides a safe and fun experience for campers who need to arrive before 9:00am or leave after 5:00pm. All campers are supervised by camp counselors assigned to before or after care. Campers in Before or After care will be grouped together in one area.
 - Before care: 8:00-9:00am
 - After care: 5:00-6:00pm
- If you need to drop your camper(s) off earlier than 9:00am or pick them up after 5:00pm, **you must arrange this in advance.** You will be charged in advance an additional supervision fee for this arrangement according to the following:
 - ALL 5 Days - \$40.00 (1st camper) in advance for Before OR After Care
 - ALL 5 Days - \$20.00 (each additional sibling) in advance for Before OR After Care
 - ALL 5 Days - \$60.00 (1st camper) in advance for **both** Before AND After Care
 - ALL 5 Days - \$30.00 (each additional sibling) in advance for **both** Before AND After Care

- Individual Days - \$10.00 (1st camper) in advance Before OR After Care
- Individual Days - \$5.00 (each additional sibling) in advance Before OR After Care

- Individual Days - \$15.00 (1st camper) in advance for **both** Before AND After Care
- Individual Days - \$5.00 (each additional sibling) in advance for **both** Before AND After Care

Before and After Care may be purchased online in conjunction with or separately of the camp registration purchase.

- If you do not make previous arrangements with the Camp Coordinator for additional supervision of your camper(s) outside of our camp pick-up and drop-off times, you will be charged \$15 per camper for each time supervision is needed before 9:00am or after 5:00pm. CASH only, no change, to pay immediately upon drop off or pick up.

MANDATORY FORMS- Required for ALL Campers

Forms can be returned at any time; but **no later** than the due dates listed below. In some cases, there might be availability for a standby camper on the waiting list or openings still available online. If you registered for a camp week after the due date listed below; your forms are due immediately.

NOTE: *If your camper(s) are attending multiple weeks you will only need to return **one** set of forms for all camp weeks per camper(s). Forms are required no later than the due date listed above in accordance with their first camp week.*

Campers will not be allowed to participate in camp without complete Pyramid Kids Camp Forms on file on the first day of camp. No Refunds will be processed for activities missed due to missing or incomplete forms, or delay in drop off. If forms are not submitted, you will be directed out of the car line into a parking space to fill out all required forms before your camper(s) are allowed out of the car.

All forms are included in the appendix of this Parent Guide and must be on file with the Moody Gardens Education Department prior to each camper beginning their camp adventure.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **How can I be sure to get the camp adventures I want for my child?**
The best way is to register as far in advance as possible before your intended camp week.
- **How can I find out which camps are available?**
The Education Web Store registration portal will indicate which camps are available. If a camp date or adventure is not listed, all spots have been booked. For further information, please contact the Education Department at (409)683-4211.
- **What is the best way to register a carpool so that all children have camps on the same week?**
Have everyone register all campers online on the same day as early as possible. Unfortunately, there is no guarantee that we will have available spots for all campers in your carpool, especially if registered separately and days apart.
- **I registered my gifted camper; will there be advanced learning?**
Our camp counselors are trained to identify and encourage advanced youth in engaging activities and group leadership roles designed for their minds. However, gifted campers will not be separated from the main camp group.
- **May I register my child not in the grades listed?**
We enforce age requirements and campers must be in the stated grade levels for camp.
- **Can you administer medications to my camper?**
Moody Gardens is NOT responsible for administering medication to campers. You may either stop by the Learning Place to administer medication directly to your camper, or speak to your pediatrician about altering your camper's dosage so that their medication can be administered outside of camp hours.
- **Can you accommodate my camper with special needs?**
We are happy to try to accommodate all campers with special needs. While we hope to offer our camp adventures to as wide of a range of campers as possible, we are unable to offer one-on-one care at this time.
We ask that you communicate with the Camp Coordinator as soon as possible to help us help your child with any of the following:
 - Accessibility concerns

- Behavioral/psychological/emotional needs
- **How do I get to Moody Gardens?**
We are located at One Hope Boulevard, Galveston, TX 77554. You may use the directions and map provided on pages 13-14 of this Parent Guide to reach our property location from the Galveston Island Causeway.
- **How should my camper dress for camp?**
All campers are required to wear their camp t-shirt each day to camp for their identification and safety while on the Moody Gardens Property with our Camp Counselors. One t-shirt is included in the registration fee for each camper. Additional t-shirts for your camper may be purchased in advance when returning forms. Campers must wear closed-toed shoes and arrive to camp with sunscreen/bug spray already applied. Campers may bring and reapply these on their own as needed throughout the day.
- **Where do I go for camp drop-off and pick-up?**
Camper drop-off and pick-up are located at the Main Parking Lot Tram Stop. We ask that parents pull up along the curb next to the tram stop and remain in vehicles to sign their camper(s) in and out each day of camp with a Camp Counselor. After you have dropped off or picked up your camper(s), please move your vehicle forward to keep the line moving. No car line before 4:30. If you arrive early you must park in a lot space. Only at 4:30 may you proceed to start the line.
If you have made previous arrangements for additional supervision for your camper before 9:00am and/or after 5:00pm, the camp coordinator will give you specific instructions on pick up or drop off procedures.
- **If I have questions or concerns, may I speak directly with my camper's Camp Counselor during drop-off or pick-up?**
Camp Counselors or parents may request one-on-one conferences with each other to address inquiries regarding camp activities and policies or behavioral needs of their campers. In this case, parents will be asked to pull forward, stay in the car and park in a designated spot.
- **What are the qualifications of your Camp Counselors?**
All Camp Counselors are employees of Moody Gardens within the Education Department that have passed a background check, state youth protection training, are CPR and first aid certified, and enjoy working with children. They have received

additional training and experience in order to conduct and supervise children in a camp program setting.

- **How are Campers supervised during camp hours?**

Campers are supervised by Camp Counselors and/or Education Department staff members at all times, with a minimum counselor-to-camper ratio of 1:12. They are escorted by camp staff in their groups and are never allowed to leave the group unattended to the restrooms, attractions, or other activity locations around property. For your child's safety, all campers must be dropped off/picked up by an authorized adult/parent/guardian and signed in and out EVERY DAY. Please also note that campers will be given ID Badges that must be worn to ensure their safety and identification by our staff members during camp hours.

- **My child can't swim; how can they go to Palm Beach?**

Campers will be restricted to one area only of Palm Beach with slides, spray features and a minimal water depth (above the ankle). No swimming is involved for any camper regardless if they can or cannot swim. Campers are within their group and wearing camp shirts for identification at all times. All exits of this area are monitored by Camp Counselors and Life Guards are on duty.

- **May parents/guardians stay in the camp with their campers?**

Our day camp adventures promote independent learning and socialization in all camp participants. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate parent/guardian requests to remain with your camper during their camp experience. If you feel that your camper is unable to remain in camp without you, we suggest waiting a year before sending them to camp. You may also arrange to have a shorter day for your camper and pick up early. There is no discount for half day; regular day camp fees apply.

- **We have an annual pass; can parents tag along with campers in attractions?**

We respectfully request that you visit the attractions on other days for family time and allow your camper to experience Pyramid Kids Camp with only fellow campers and counselors. We will not disclose our daily schedules for this reason. You are welcome to sign out your camper from camp to visit Moody Gardens as a family.

- **What are the behavior expectations for campers?**

Camp rules and expectations are posted in each of our classrooms and are emphasized by our Camp Counselors throughout each day. They are listed below for reference:

- 1) Stay together as a group, especially when walking over to the Aquarium, Rainforest or other attractions. NEVER be alone at any time.
- 2) Be respectful to your fellow campers, give them space, and keep your hands and feet to yourself. If you cannot keep hands and feet to yourself you will be removed from the activity and your parent/guardian called.
- 3) When a Counselor is speaking, everyone should be listening, quiet and respectful.
- 4) While traveling across property, everyone should be on their best behavior, which means no running, yelling or horse playing.
- 5) Take responsibility for following the camp rules and encourage your fellow campers to do the same.
- 6) **The use of phones and electronic devices is not permitted during camp activities unless they are being used to take pictures while visiting attractions.** Your camper will be instructed to put phones away when not taking photos. Tablets or other electronic devices are not permitted to camp.
- 7) **Campers are not permitted to bring toys or other distractions to camp.**
- 8) We are unable to visit concession stands, food courts, or gift shops during camp hours. Therefore, **please do not send your camper to camp with cash.** Campers must have a lunch brought from home each day they attend camp.


- **Can my camper bring valuables to camp such as electronic devices?**

We do not permit personal toys or the general use of cell phones, tablets or other electronic devices during camp hours. If they are with your camper and become a distraction, they will be taken up for the remainder of the day and returned at pick up. Moody Gardens is not responsible for loss or damage to your camper's personal belongings. It is highly advised they stay home.

- **Does my child need to bring a lunch to camp?**

Campers are required to bring a non-perishable lunch to camp. Unfortunately, we are unable to restrict the items that other parents provide in their camper's lunch. In the case of severe food allergies, it is not possible for us to monitor the food other campers bring to camp.

- **What kinds of snacks do you offer to campers throughout the camp day?
Can I send specialized snacks for my camper?**
Yes, you can send additional snacks for your camper, especially if he or she is a picky eater. Campers will receive a grab and go snack in the morning and afternoon each day of camp. Please indicate any food allergies on your camper's Medical Release Form.
- **Who may I contact during the day if I need to leave an emergency message concerning my child?**
You may contact our Camp Coordinator at (409)683-4211 or the Education Curator at (409)683-4233. In the event neither of them can answer the phone contact the main operator at (409)683-4200.
- **Does the camp qualify for the child care tax credit?**
Yes, Moody Gardens' Pyramid Kids Day Camps falls under the tax credit eligibility. A tax receipt for camp will only be issued at the end of the camp season in order to verify attendance of camper(s) and payment from the requestor confirmed. This receipt is issued only upon written request. Send a request email to camps@moodygardens.org with the online purchase transaction number, camper(s) name and proper name(s) of requestor (those filing for credit). However, your eligibility for any Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit depends on your personal tax situation. Please consult with a professional tax advisor and/or refer to the IRS Publication 503 "Child and Dependent Care Expenses". Moody Gardens is not responsible for/nor guarantees any potential tax credit.




Directions to Moody Gardens Education Department

- 1) Take the exit to 61st Street from either direction on Gulf Freeway/Broadway (I-45)
- 2) Travel for approximately one mile, then make a right onto Stewart Road.
- 3) Travel for a half mile. When you come to the fork in the road, keep right onto Jones Dr.
- 4) Take Jones Dr. for approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile. Make a right at the light onto One Hope Blvd. Stay in the right lane and follow the signs towards the Attractions.
